



OSU Chinese Flagship Requirements

- Advanced language defined by major media
- Culture-based language study
- Master's degree: level 3 proficiency, domain, thesis or Master's project in Chinese

“Until now Chinese has been adapted to you. In this program, we will adapt you to the Chinese Language and culture.”

Critical Experience for Advanced Proficiencies in Chinese

- Having worked in a Chinese organization with the intention to achieve a shared goal.
- Having developed a special set of skills in the language either around a particular group of people or a specific body of knowledge.

Teaching Advanced Chinese at OSU

- Language pedagogy experts
- Chinese experts in many disciplines
- Capturing media for instruction
- Internship program (US/China Links)

Summer in Qingdao

AU: Chinese 760—Networking in China and the United States: Relationship building and maintenance in Chinese and American cultures. Bilingual sessions.

Chinese 694/717 Analysis of Chinese Media Presentation: A study of Chinese broadcast, Internet, and print media.

Wi: Chinese 755--Languages in China: A Survey of language issues in China: writing systems, language variation, minority languages, language and gender.

Chinese 770--Literary Chinese in Modern Mandarin: Study of the rhetorical role of classical and literary expressions in modern

formal discourses.

Sp: Chinese 615--China's Perspectives on Chinese Civilization: A survey of Chinese history from the perspectives of Chinese scholars.

Chinese 750-- Negotiation in Chinese Culture: Analysis and simulation of negotiating in informal and formal situations in the workplaces of China.

Summer through Winter:

Qingdao community projects and individualized instruction, Au: Nanjing University, WI: internships.

SP: completion of degree: testing, thesis, placement.

Performed Culture in the Classroom

- Content courses taught by experts from China in their accustomed manner
- Pedagogy specialist working to bridge the “expectations gap” between teacher and students
- Extracurricular involvement in Central Ohio Chinese community
