

International Program Highlights

- 28 programs *require or will soon require* study abroad in order to graduate.
- 13,686 students have studied abroad in the past 13 years: a 998% increase in that time. This is 21.5% participation rate.
- 661 faculty have been supported by 459 IP grants during the past 10 years.
- SDSU offers 335 programs in 52 countries.
- The proportion of Hispanic students that participate in study abroad is higher than their proportion in the general student population.
- Student Fulbright awards: last year 5; this year 15 recommended. Largest ever for SDSU.
- For *four* years in a row, SDSU was ranked #1 for study abroad in California in our Carnegie Classification (Research University/High Activity). Ranked #3 nationally. Named in top 40 Doctoral Universities (#22, up from #30 last year) for study abroad.
- Ranked #2 in the nation for sending students abroad with disabilities.
- Awarded 2010 International Prize from University Design Consortium (ASU) for requiring study abroad.
